To Whom It May Concern,

Renon Power certifies that our battery energy storage products, when paired with qualified inverters, may qualify as “Solar Electric Property” under Internal Revenue Code 25D (Residential) and 48E (Commercial).

This guidance is intended to assist customers, installers, and distributors in understanding potential eligibility for the Federal Investment Tax Credit (ITC) as updated by the OBBBA (2025 amendments).

Residential ITC (Section 25D)

Homeowners installing a qualified Renon residential system (Xtreme LV, Xcellent Plus, EBrick) may be eligible for up to a 30% ITC on the total installed cost if the system is fully installed by December 31, 2025. The system must use solar energy to generate electricity for a U.S. residence.

Commercial ITC (Section 48E)

For commercial installations (ECube, MPack, SmartMatrix), projects may qualify for ITC when construction commences before December 31, 2025. The project is deemed commenced if at least 5% of project costs (such as battery procurement) are incurred by this time.

U.S. Manufacturing & Compliance Commitment

Renon Power USA is committed to supporting U.S. clean energy goals through domestic production and responsible supply chain practices. With the recent acquisition of our 67,000 sq. ft. facility in McKinney, Texas, Renon Power is expanding US-based manufacturing of advanced battery energy storage systems.

This investment is designed to help customers and partners benefit from federal incentives tied to **Build America, Buy America (BABA)** provisions and **Domestic Content** requirements under the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA). In parallel, Renon Power is actively structuring its supply chain to align with **Foreign Entity of Concern (FEOC)** restrictions,



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ensuring long-term eligibility for tax credits, grants, and federal procurement opportunities.

By investing in U.S. operations and prioritizing compliance with BABA, Domestic Content, and FEOC standards, Renon Power provides customers, installers, and developers with greater confidence that our products will remain positioned to support evolving federal incentives and procurement rules.
